All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Pursuant to the order of this court, dated July 06, 2020, though it had been directed that a Deputy Commissioner of Police should file an affidavit, however, it has been filed by an Assistant Commissioner of Police; but be that as it may, since it is filed by a gazetted officer who states that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner and the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, hence for the reasons already stated in the aforesaid order of this court, the present petition is allowed, with the order dated July 06, 2020, made

absolute on the same terms and conditions.

In the present petition though learned counsel for the petitioner again submits that the matter has been compromised with the complainant even by the present petitioner. However, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has still to join investigation.

Consequently, adjourned to 20.08.2020, with the petitioner directed to join investigation immediately, within three days, failing which the interim order dated July 30, 2020, shall stand automatically vacated, with instructions to be taken by the learned State counsel as to whether the matter has been fully compromised with all the accused or not.

Learned State counsel will also determine the fate of the petition filed by the petitioner and his co-accused seeking quashing of the FIR itself.
