The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Notice of motion to official respondents.

Mr. Sanjay Mittal, Addl. A.G. Haryana puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to him.

The present civil writ petition has come about by petitioner Kumari Urmila Yadav seeking indulgence of this Court for issuance of a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to decide the representation of the petition Annexure P-7 dated 29.01.2020.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in the advertisement itself, it was mentioned that the appointments would be made district wise and a district-wise cadre would be maintained and that the districts would be allocated to the successful candidates on the basis of their merit in accordance with their choice. Each of the candidates was required to mention his six preferences in the application form.

Heard.

In the light of the same and keeping in view the averments made in the petition and the contentions raised by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed off with the directions to the official respondent No. 2-Director, Elementary Education, Haryana to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 29.01.2020 (Annexure P-7) fully in accordance with law by way of passing a speaking order expeditiously, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
