The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a petition filed under
Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 171 dated 11.06.2020 under Sections 21/22
of the NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the said Act added later on), P.S.
Sadar Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

On 07.07.2020, the following order was passed:-

*“Inter alia contends that Kuldeep Singh @ Geeta
and Tarsem Singh @ Sonu were arrested with the
contraband and the petitioner has only been involved
on their statements. It is submitted that the petitioner is
not involved in any similar case.*

Notice of motion.

*Mr. H.S. Sullar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on
behalf of the respondent/State.*

List on 28.08.2020.

*In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioner
shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the*

petitioner, she shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation, which fact is vouched for by counsel for the State on instructions from SI Bhagatveer Singh. It is further also the common case that there is no other case of similar nature against the petitioner.

Accordingly, the order dated 07.07.2020 is confirmed and the petition stands disposed of accordingly.
