Petitioner has preferred this writ petition for the issuance of appropriate order or writ especially directing the respondents to decide his representation dated 24.01.2020 in respect of non-deposit of petitioner's provident fund and also to decide the legal notice dated 30.12.2019 in respect of pending payments of the petitioner towards medical bills and other payments made by the petitioner from his own pocket.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the payments made by the petitioners from time to time were duly approved and passed by the competent authority, but the amount has not been released to him. A legal notice dated 30.12.2019 (Annexure P-5) and representation dated 24.01.2020 (Annexure P-6) are pending in the aforesaid context before respondent No.3.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Deepak Manchanda, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage, as no order prejudicial to the interest of respondents is being passed.

At this juncture, this Court is not in a position to appreciate the allegations of the petitioner, however respondent No.3 can be asked to have a fair look at the grievance of the petitioner for which legal notice dated 30.12.2019 (Annexure P-5) and representation dated 24.01.2020 (Annexure P-6) have already been moved by him.

In view of above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 30.12.2019 (Annexure P-5) and representation dated 24.01.2020 (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioner in the context of his claim. The needful be done within a period of two months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
