The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.93 dated 13.06.2019, under Section 304-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 465, 468 and 471 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajandeep Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
