ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL)

The writ petitioners have filed the present writ petition with prayer for the following substantive reliefs:-

- (i) *A writ in the nature of mandamus directing be issued for directing any of the respondent from respondents no.4 to 6 to submit supplementary exam form and fee of petitioners online and further directions be issued to the respondent no.2 to open online portal and accept supplementary exam July/August 2020 forms of the petitioners and for taking their supplementary examination (petitioner No.1 to 3 in midwifery and petitioner no.4 in health centre management (HCM) exam) in the interest of justice.*
- (ii) *for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent no.1 and 2 to shift the petitioners with respondent no.6 or any other suitable institute who complete all the formalities of institute without any harm. Further harassment or mental agony to the petitioners, in the interest of justice.*
- (iii) *for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent no.1 to get registered a criminal case against the respondents no.3 to 5 for committing fraud with the petitioners in lust of money and for destroying the carrier of student i.e. Petitioners;*
- (iv) *further prayed that the petitioners be awarded compensation of Rs.10 lacs for loss, harassment and*

mental agony.”

Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.2-Punjab Nurses Registration Council has submitted that the admission form for supplementary examaminations submitted by the college of the petitioners has been accepted and the petitioners along with 7 other non-petitioners shall be permitted to write the exam.

In view thereof, the present writ petition has become infructuous qua relief no.(i) and (ii).

As regards, relief No.(iii) and (iv), the petitioners are relegated to the alternative remedy.

Disposed of accordingly.
