Mr. Chetan Sharma, AAG, Haryana, on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar, SHO, Police Station Sadar, Ambala, has made a statement that the alleged detainee Rajesh Kumar son of Jai Bhagwan is accused in FIR No.246, dated 29.06.2020, registered under Sections 188/323/452 IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Ambala. The detainee was arrested and was released on bail on 29.06.2020 as the offences were bailable.

Keeping in view the aforesaid statement, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
