Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.187 dated 25.11.2019 lodged under Sections 304, 201, 34 IPC at Police Station Nakodar (Sadar) District Jalandhar.

On 07.07.2020, the following order had been passed:

“Inter alia contends that as per the FIR Paramveer Singh, the deceased was taken away by two boys namely Harshal and Ranjeet Singh @ Jeeta and, thereafter, his dead body was found lying. It is submitted that the petitioner has only been involved in the FIR at the instance of the said persons on the ground that the intoxicating material which was administered to the deceased had been purchased from the petitioner. It is, thus, submitted that the petitioner is not liable for the death of the deceased in any manner and the anticipatory bail has wrongly been denied on the ground that he is indulging in a drug trade.

Notice of motion.

Mr. H.S. Sullar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail by the investigating officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

State Counsel, on instructions from SI-Inderjit Singh submits that no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, in view of the above, the interim bail granted on 07.07.2020 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
