The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0062 dated 24.04.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 379-B IPC at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana.

On 09.07.2020, following order was passed:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per allegations in the FIR, Karan and Anmol @ Mohit (petitioner) came on a motorcycle and stopped the complainant and started abusing him. One more person namely Angad who was accompanied by unknown person came on a Activa scooter duly armed with baseball bat and stick and started beating the complainant. Angad snatched an amount of Rs.35,000/- from the pocket of the complainant. Out of the aforesaid amount, an amount of Rs.20,000/- was given by the father of the complainant and remaining amount of Rs.15,000/- was received from milk business. Co-accused Karan filed CRM-M No.16828 of 2020 for grant of anticipatory bail in which notice of motion has been issued for 08.09.2020 along with interim bail.

Learned counsel further contends that the alleged complicity of the petitioner is at par with that of co-accused namely Karan.

Notice of motion for 08.09.2020.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. J.P. Ratra, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Interim order in the same terms as passed in CRM-M No.16828 of 2020.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.16828 of 2020.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 09.07.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the

investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
