The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.50 dated 3.3.2020, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala, under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the report of chemical examiner has not yet been received and thus, he prays only for grant of interim bail to the petitioner till the receipt of the report of chemical examiner.

Learned State counsel admits that the report of the chemical examiner has not yet been received.

Thus, I deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioner till the receipt of the report of the chemical examiner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqah Duty Magistrate, concerned till the date of

receipt of the report of the chemical examiner. He is directed to surrender before the trial Court concerned on the date the said report is presented.
