Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to face trial and to associate with the proceedings of the trial.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner chooses to surrender before the trial Court within a period of three weeks from today and applies for grant of regular bail, the learned trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of two days from filing of such application keeping in view the fact that all other co-accused have already been acquitted.
