The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 22.7.2019 (Annexure P-1) vide which CRM-M-30840-2019 was disposed of with a directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police to look into the representation dated 19.6.2019 and take required action thereon, if any, as per law.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the FIR has been registered to which learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR had already been registered even prior to the filing of the CRM. In any case, in pursuance to the said FIR, accused Jai Parkash was arrested on 27.7.2020 and Rs.4,000/- were recovered from him.

The petitioner is still aggrieved. It is stated that one main accused has not arrested inspite of the anticipatory bail having been dismissed.

This Court has no doubt that the investigation shall be done in accordance with law and shall be taken to its logical conclusion and the needful as required will be done. However, no contempt is made out.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.
