The present contempt petition has been filed for non compliance of order dated 12.12.2019 passed in CWP No. 8675 of 2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner although does not dispute that the order has been complied with but is still aggrieved with the date from which the interest has been given on the delayed payment.

Learned State counsel however submits that the said interest has been given in compliance of the order and as per law laid down in the case of **J.S. Cheema Versus State of Haryana, 2014 (13) RCR (Civil) 355** as directed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner accordingly states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present contempt petition with liberty to seek clarification with respect to the date of interest from which the petitioner is entitled.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
