In this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* to restrain respondent No.2 from implementing the order dated 17.3.2020. Besides, a further prayer has also been made for directing respondent No.1 to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner expeditiously.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondent No.2 to look into the appeal dated 18.5.2020 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate action.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 – Sub Divisional Canal Officer, Narwana, Water Service Sub Division, Tohana District

Fatehabad, to look into the representation/appeal dated 18.5.2020 (Annexure P-7) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within two months, from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
