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Learned counsel appearing for Union of India submits that since the petitioner did not join service after proceeding on leave, a departmental enquiry was held and as a result thereof, he was dismissed from service as per presidential order dated 24.06.2005. This presidential order has not been challenged till today. Counsel further submits that in view of the presidential order, there is no requirement of recovery of Rs.2,28,054/- from the petitioner. Learned counsel has placed on record a signal from the Headquarters of CRPF (Signal Branch). It is taken on record.

The above being the accepted position, the writ petition consequently becomes infructuous and is disposed of as such.
