Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks the grant of regular bail in FIR No.39 dated 04.02.2019, registered under Sections 302, 365, 201, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak, District Rohtak.

As per the case of the prosecution the petitioner along with his co-accused abducted and then murdered one Harish Kumar. Such abduction and murder was done at the behest of one Parveen who was a nephew of Harish Kumar (deceased) and with whom Parveen had a money dispute.

The allegations against the petitioner are with regard to abduction and murder of one Harish Kumar; during investigation the petitioner has given to the investigating agency details of the crime he is alleged to have committed; he also got the place of occurrence demarcated; in addition to the present case he is also involved in FIR No.204/2019 under

Sections 399, 402 IPC and 25, 54, 59 Arms Act registered at Police Station Shanjahpur, Rajasthan and FIR No.205/2019 under Section 392, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Basantkunj North, New Delhi; co-accused Parveen @ Mota and Parveen Hooda have been declared proclaimed offenders and eye-witnesses in the case are yet to be examined.

In the view of the above this Court is not inclined to grant to the petitioner the concession of regular bail.

Dismissed.
