Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.0127 dated 10.08.2018 under Section 376 IPC, registered at Police Station Dirba (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 12.08.2018/13.08.2018 (Annexures P-2 & P-3).

Learned State Counsel submits that the police has already prepared the cancellation report and the same was presented before the court on 12.04.2019 and on 13.07.2019 even the prosecutrix has appeared before the trial court and made a statement that she has no objection in case cancellation report is accepted. However, the trial court has directed the police to have further investigation in the case.

In view of the fact that the police has already prepared the

cancellation report, faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, in case, the police files a fresh cancellation report and the same is not accepted by the trial court, petitioner would be at liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of FIR in question on the basis of compromise.
