Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3, to protect their (petitioners) lives and liberty from respondent Nos. 4 to 9.

Counsel for the petitioners would argue that though there was valid divorce in respect of previous marriage(s) of the petitioners with their respective spouses but even if their previous spouses have an issue to raise against performance of marriage of the petitioners, they can seek recourse to appropriate remedy in law. It is further submitted that previous spouses of the petitioners have not been arrayed as respondents nor the petitioners have

expressed any apprehension of danger to their life and liberty at their hands. The last submission made by counsel is that private respondents (family members of petitioners) can not be allowed to take law in their hands or cause danger to life and liberty of the petitioners, in violation of provisions of Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

Without meaning to express any opinion on the merits of controversy and going into the question of validity or otherwise of marriage, petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to make a representation to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal within a period of seven days. In case, such a representation is made, the Superintendent of Police, Palwal is directed to look into grievance of the petitioners and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances, in accordance with law.
