The petitioner is the accused in FIR No. 100 dated 06.06.2020 on the file of Police Station Koom Kalan, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, registered under Sections 306 IPC. As per Sukhjeet Kaur, the complainant, her brother, Jagmohan Singh, gave Rs. 10.00 lakh to the petitioner seven years ago but he failed to carry out his promise or return the same. Depressed over this issue, her brother is stated to have committed suicide by consuming poison.

By order dated 14.7.2020, this Court directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer was directed to admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing upon his furnishing adequate security.

Mr. H.S. Sullar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, would state on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh, Police Station Koom Kalan, that the petitioner joined the investigation pursuant to the aforesaid order and that his custodial interrogation

is not required at present.

Though, Mr. G.S. Verma, learned counsel appearing for the complainant, would oppose this bail petition, the aforestated facts demonstrate that the petitioner joined the investigation in the case to the satisfaction of the police and his custodial interrogation is stated to be unnecessary at this stage.

The petition is accordingly allowed. The petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the police in the course of the investigation in FIR No. 100 dated 06.06.2020, on the file of Police Station Koom Kalan, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana. In the event his arrest is warranted in future in relation to this case, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer concerned. In such an event, the petitioner shall also abide by the conditions prescribed in Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
