Prayer in the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the full and final retiral benefits such as Gratuity, Leave Encashment etc. along with arrears of salary due.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed a petition dated 25.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) before the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, District Administrative Complex, Moga, claiming the aforesaid benefits, which has not been taken cognizance of.

He further states that he would be satisfied, if aforesaid petition (Annexure P-3) is decided by respondent No.4-Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, District Administrative Complex, Moga, within a stipulated period.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 4-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to decide the petition (Annexure P-3) stated to be pending before him within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
