Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking protection of their life and liberty as well as a direction to the official respondents to take action on the complaints made by them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that petitioner No. 1 had received a serious injury in the incident including fracture of his skull, but the police authorities have not taken any action in the matter. He has referred to the copy of the MLR, which is annexed as Annexure P2. He also contends that inadvertently Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar has been impleaded as respondent No. 3 instead of Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala. He further contends that the petitioners shall be making a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, who may be directed to consider the same and take action in accordance with law.

At his oral request, respondent No. 3 would be read as Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala.

Issue notice to respondents No. 1 to 4 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Abhaypal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, that in the event of the petitioners making a representation, the same shall be considered and necessary action be taken thereon in accordance with law.
