The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner Sukhjinder Singh has prayed for a direction to the respondents to release him on parole for a period of 6 weeks for taking necessary care of his ill wife and minor daughter as there is no one in the family to look after them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner based upon the pleadings submits that this Court vide order dated 24.10.2019 passed in CWP No.26228 of 2019 had granted parole for 8 weeks on the ground that the petitioner has to take care of his wife and his daughter. Learned counsel submits that the SSP, Tarn Taran has lost sight of the fact that this Court had earlier granted parole to the petitioner who had not jumped the parole and had surrendered before the Central Jail, Amritsar.

In view of the above the petitioner is granted parole for a period of 6 weeks from the date of release, to the satisfaction of District Magistrate concerned. The concerned authority is directed to impose such conditions as may be required in the Jail Manual in order to secure the presence of the petitioner after the period of parole is over. The conditions may also cover the report dated 11.04.2020 given by SSP Tarn Taran (P2) so that the temporary release is not misused.
