The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 21.11.2019 vide which the writ petition was allowed and a direction was issued to the respondents to release all the pensionary benefits of the petitioner alongwith interest @ 9% per annum from the date the petitioner retired till the amount will be released to him by the respondents.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the entire amount due to the petitioner towards the pensionary benefits has since been paid.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is disposed of at this stage.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the arrears towards second ACP has still not been granted. The said ACP was withheld because of non-passing of the typing test. The said requirement was set aside and it was in those circumstances that the writ petition was allowed. Therefore, the respondents are supposed to pay the arrears of second ACP also.

In view of the same, the respondents shall consider the release of the second ACP as well and in case the petitioner is found entitled, the same too be released forthwith. In case, the petitioner is not found entitled, the respondents shall pass a speaking order within four weeks from today.
