Power of attorney of Mr. Hitesh Pandit, learned counsel for the respondents, has been received. Along with the said power of attorney is an order dated 09.07.2020 passed by the Chief Engineer/OP, UHBVN, Panchkula, according to which the office order dated 29.05.2020 vide which petitioner-Nathu Ram was retired on 31.05.2020, stands withdrawn and the competent authority has decided to grant extension in service to him beyond the age of 58 years being handicapped.

In the light of the above order as well as the statement of the counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

It goes without saying that the petitioner would be entitled to the pay and allowances for the period for which he was out of service during the interregnum, which shall be disbursed to him within a period of two months.
