The petitioners have been granted the benefit of anticipatory

bail in the above said three cases vide orders dated 29.06.2020, 09.07.2020 and 16.07.2020 in case FIR No.53 dated 17.06.2020 under Sections 323, 341, 365, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Counsel for the State submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for as the recovery as such has been effected.

The confirmation of the interim orders are vehemently opposed by Mr. Ritesh Pandey, counsel for the complainant.

Keeping in view the submissions recorded on an earlier occasion it would be clear that the parties have been litigating on an earlier occasion. The complainant had earlier also initiated proceedings against one of the petitioner namely Akshay Saini in CRM-M-17888-2020 when he was juvenile and he was acquitted by the Juvenile Justice Board, Gurdaspur on 22.02.2019.

This Court is of the opinion that the interim orders are liable to be confirmed keeping in mind the background of the parties and the manner in which incident has taken place in the village. Accordingly, petitions are disposed of by confirming the interim bail orders i.e. 29.06.2020, 09.07.2020 and 16.07.2020.
