The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No.100 dated 20.06.2020 on the file of Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot, registered under Sections 353, 186, 506, and 34 IPC. He filed this petition seeking grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

The case of the complainant was that the petitioner along with another person attacked him for the reason that he had illicit relations with his wife. By order dated 08.07.2020 passed in this case, this Court directed the petitioner to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was granted the relief of interim bail subject to furnishing a personal bond and surety to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. He was further asked to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and

abide by the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Mr. M.S. Dullat, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, would inform this Court that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner joined investigation in this case and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed in terms of the interim order dated 08.07.2020. The personal bond and surety offered by the petitioner shall be kept alive till the disposal of the case. The petitioner shall continue to cooperate with the investigation and also abide by the conditions prescribed in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
