2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing respondent No.2, to take action on the representation (Annexure P-1) dated 26.05.2020 for registration of a case under Section 295-A IPC, as well as under the Cyber Laws.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already made representation (Annexure P-1) dated 26.05.2020 to respondent No.2 i.e. the Director General of Police, Punjab but till date, no action has been taken.
