1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for intentionally and willfully violating judgment (Annexure P-1) dated 27.02.2020 in CWP No.290 of 2019.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that vide order dated 20.07.2020, Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.444 of 2020 has stayed the operation of judgment (Annexure P-1) dated 27.02.2020 in CWP No.290 of 2019, therefore, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such, at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, pursuant to the decision of the aforementioned LPA, if the circumstances,

4. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.
5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed, at this stage, with the liberty, as prayed for.
