The petition has been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

In the present contempt petition, the petitioner is alleging deliberate and intentional violation of order dated 27.02.2020 passed by this Court in CWP No.170 of 2019 titled as Ved Prakash vs. State of Haryana and others (Annexure P/1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the benefit of regularization of services of the petitioner w.e.f 1.10.2003 or from the date the services of the junior of the petitioner were regularized, has not been extended to the petitioner so far, though, a period of four and half months has already elapsed.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of

advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Mohhit Sharma, ADA, Animal Husbandry Department submits that the State has already decided to file a Letter Patents Appeal against the order dated 27.02.2020, violation of which has been alleged in the present contempt petition and for this purpose, the respondents be granted a period of one month, within which, the order dated 27.02.2020 passed by this Court in CWP No.170 of 2019 (Annexure P/1) will be implemented, in case, there is no interim order passed in favour of the State in the said LPA.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, he does not press the present contempt petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.

The present contempt petition stands disposed of as having been not pressed.

The respondents will be bound by their statement recorded above.

It is made clear that in case, the violation of the above recorded statement of the respondents is brought to the notice of this Court, a strict view will be taken by this Court against the respondents.
