Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.60 dated 19.06.2020 under Sections 326, 323, 324, 427, 447, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR has been registered against seven persons including the petitioner, who is 72 years of age and only allegation against him is that he has given some fist blows. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and there are specific allegations against other accused persons.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State while Mr. Ritesh Pandey,

Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant.

Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has submitted that though there are cases pending against other accused persons and there are number of injuries sustained by injured Daljit Singh and Amrik Singh at the instance of other accused persons, however, injury No.7 suffered by Daljit Singh and injury No.8 suffered by Amrik Singh are not attributable to petitioner Didar Singh.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the allegations against the petitioner and his age, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
