Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.109, dated 06.07.2019, under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, present petitioner is the nephew of the deceased, Gurcharan Singh, who died on 05.07.2019.

Allegations are that the present petitioner along with the sister and brother-in-law of the deceased inflicted fatal injuries upon the deceased.

Petitioner was arrested on 06.07.2019.

Motive attributed is of property dispute.

During the course of hearing, it has gone uncontroverted that material witnesses i.e. mother, father and nephew of the deceased have not

supported the prosecution version and have been declared hostile.

It is a case of circumstantial evidence there being no eye witness.

Co-accused, Daljit Kaur and Dharam Singh i.e. sister and brother-in-law of the deceased have been granted benefit of bail by this Court in the light of order dated 30.06.2020 in CRM-M-15123-2020.

In view of the above and on the ground of parity, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
