The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.76 dated 19.04.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 427, 452, 188, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sahnewal, Ludhiana.

On 09.07.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged occurrence is in two parts. In the occurrence dated 17.4.2020, there is no role attributed to the petitioner. In the second occurrence dated 18.4.2020, the petitioner has not been attributed any specific role vis-a-vis the injury on the person of Parwinder Singh (brother of the complainant) except to allege that Dharminder Singh along with petitioner Jagroop Singh, Gurpartap Singh and 8-10 unknown persons duly armed with kirpans, baseballs and sticks etc. came on motorcycles. After parking the motorcycles in front of the house of the complainant, they immediately came down. Dharminder Singh waved his licenced revolver and raised a lalkara to give severe beatings to the family members of the complainant. Brother of the complainant, namely, Parwinder Singh was standing in verandah and accused persons caught him and gave beatings. Parwinder Singh ran towards stairs leading to terrace. He was again caught and was given beatings. Gurpartap Singh gave baseball blow to Parwinder Singh on his right leg on knee, ankle and right hand. The occurrence took place at about 10.00 pm on 18.4.2020. The offences except the offence under Section 452 IPC are bailable in nature.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr.J.P.Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 14.7.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the

conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List again on 26.8.2020.”

Thereafter, vide order dated 26.08.2020, petitioner was again directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Kulwinder Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim orders dated 09.07.2020 and 26.08.2020 are made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
