Prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail. The first bail application was dismissed on 5.2.2020. The second bail application was dismissed on 29.5.2020. Both times the matter was dismissed as withdrawn after learned counsel had argued for sometime. Thereafter, the present third bail application has been filed. Not a word has been mentioned in the entire bail application with respect to the fresh ground for filing the third bail application.

On being confronted, as this Court almost missed noticing the earlier two bail applications, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is in custody since last seven months and the injured was also out of the hospital after three days and there was only one injury and which was simple in nature.

All these grounds were available to the petitioner even during the previous two bail applications except the ground that the petitioner is in custody since seven months. In the present case, the complainant is alive to

inflicted two injuries and not one as alleged by learned counsel. Both the injuries are with sharp edge weapon. They find mentioned in the injury report. The evidence in the form of the statement of the injured witness which is duly mentioned in the FIR is supported by the medical evidence. One injury was found on the stomach on the left side of the abdomen and the second was on the thigh. The injuries were found to be dangerous for life.

In view of the above, no ground for bail is made out.

Dismissed accordingly.
