This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus seeking directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

On 07.07.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Mr. Randhir Thind, DAG, Punjab, is directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 17.07.2020.”

Today learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Lakhvir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Barnala on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, wherein it is mentioned that respondent Nos.4 and 5 (parents of petitioner No.1) are not objecting to the alleged matrimonial alliance of the petitioners. Their

statement/joint affidavit dated 13.07.2020 is also appended with the reply (Annexure R-1/T).

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petition is rendered infructuous.

The petition is disposed off as such.
