The petitioner is residing in Australia. Her husband i.e. respondent has filed a divorce petition in the family Court at Amritsar wherein the petitioner has put in appearance through her mother as General Power of Attorney. The present petition has been filed for transfer of the case from Amritsar to Jalandhar on the ground that the mother is old and infirm.

According to the petition, mother of the petitioner is aged only 56 years and, thus, it can not be said that she is very old. On being asked about the medical problems that she is suffering from, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she has back problem as well as knee problem. However, he has been unable to substantiate this submission with any documentary proof. Consequently, the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner can not be accepted.

No other reason has been cited in support of the petition. The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
