The present second petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.39 dated 10.08.2018 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 14 of Foreigners Act 1946, at Police Station STF Phase-IV, District Mohali.

Pursuant to order of the previous date; the report has been received from the trial court; in which it is stated that the arguments have never been addressed before the court for final disposal.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the submission qua the arguments having been addressed, was not made by the petitioner, rather this assertion had come from the State counsel. In any case, since the evidence of the prosecution is already over, therefore, the petitioner would avail his remedy of addressing the arguments and

getting the final decision on the trial; from the trial court itself.

Therefore, it is submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition.
