Through the present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India the petitioner seeks direction to respondent no.3 to decide the statutory appeal dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure P/3).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the appeal has been filed against the order of punishment dated 5.10.2016 (Annexure P/2) qua the charge sheet dated 8.8.2014 which is pending consideration. Counsel further submits that the petitioner is to retire on 30.11.2020 and his retiral dues are to be calculated accordingly. In case the appeal in question is allowed, the retiral dues would be enhanced. In such circumstances, he seeks direction to respondent no.3 for disposal of the appeal.

Keeping in view the limited prayer as such sought, this

Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served by issuance of notice of motion to the respondents.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to dispose of the appeal dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure P/3) which is directed against the punishment order dated 5.10.2016 (Annexure P/2) within a period of three months from the receipt of a certified copy of this order.
