GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.

1. The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.56 dated 11.5.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 379, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Batala.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the parties have since entered into a compromise as the matter has been settled amongst them amicably.
3. The aforesaid position is duly endorsed by Ms. Arti Kaur, Advocate for the complainant who has informed that the parties have indeed entered into compromise. She has specifically stated that the complainant has no

objection in case the petitioner be granted anticipatory bail.

4. Having regard to the aforesaid fact and circumstances of the case, the petition, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 9.7.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear regularly before the Trial Court and shall abide by the conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court.
