Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to conduct the fair and impartial investigation on the complaint dated 10.03.2016 given by the petitioner regarding cheating committed with him by respondent Nos. 5 to 8.

Reply, filed by way of affidavit of DSP, City-I, District S.A.S. Nagar, is on record and as per the same, the inquiry on the aforesaid complaint of the petitioner was entrusted to DSP (Investigation), S.A.S. Nagar by the S.S.P., S.A.S. Nagar and DSP (Investigation) got the said complaint inquired into by Incharge, E.O. Wing. As per the inquiry report, the allegations levelled against Parveen Kumar were proved, however, Archana Vohra, Poonam and Parminder Sehgal were found to be innocent. The DSP (Investigation) proved the report and the same was submitted before the S.S.P., S.A.S. Nagar, who, while approving the same, has filed the said complaint of the petitioner finding it to be dispute of civil nature.

In view of the above, since the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed, no further orders are called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
