Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.87 dated 18.02.2020, registered under Sections 306/34 IPC at Police Station City Narnaul, district Mahendergarh, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 19.09.2019 the petitioner's husband committed suicide because of depression and his mental state at that time which is not attributable to her; at the time of her husband's death the complainant's son i.e. her husband's brother had acknowledged that the petitioner's husband had committed suicide because of depression and his ill mental health; the FIR was lodged after an unexplained delay of five months from the date of occurrence; the lodging of the FIR is motivated as her in-laws want to preclude her from inheriting her husband's property and his retiral benefits etc. and that under the interim order of this Court dated 20.07.2020 she has not only joined the investigation but has fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mahabir Singh, submits that the petitioner has not only joined investigation but has fully cooperated with the investigation agency and that her custodial interrogation is not required.

Keeping in view the totality of the above facts and especially in view of the statement recorded by learned State counsel that under the interim order of this Court the petitioner has joined investigation/cooperated with the investigating agency and that her custodial interrogation is not required, the order of this Court dated 20.07.2020, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
