The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioners have filed this civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus so as to direct the respondents to clear the backlog of vacancies reserved for SC/ST category calculating the same as per roster point w.e.f. 17.06.1995 in terms of latest instructions dated 04.05.2018 (Annexure P-3) issued by the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 15.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) to the respondent No.3 i.e.

the Director General of Police, Haryana, but no action has been taken thereon so far.

He further states that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent/competent authority to decide the aforesaid representation dated 15.07.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Ashish Yadav, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Without expressing any opinion as regard the claim of the petitioners, but considering the fact that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 15.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) to the respondent No.2, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent/competent authority to decide the representation dated 15.07.2018 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law and the instructions as applicable in the case. It would be appreciated if the decision is taken on the said representation preferably within six months from today.
