The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.14 dated 30.01.2020 registered under Sections 406 and 420 read with Section 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

The operative part of the order dated 09.07.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“....Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR has been registered on the basis of two complaints made by complainant-Balvir Singh Multani the first for taking action against Balwinder Singh son of Bant Singh and the second for taking action against the petitioner respectively. The complainant has given the civil dispute the colour of criminal offence to pressurize the petitioner. Coaccused Balwinder Singh and Baljinder Singh have already been granted interim bail by this Court

vide orders dated 25.06.2020 and 01.07.2020 respectively. The petitioner will execute the sale deed in compliance of judgment and decree dated 21.10.2011 passed against him as per direction of the executing Court. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required in the case.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 09.07.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.07.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
