During course of hearing, it came to light that Amandeep Singh accused in FIR No.0133 dated 10.09.2019 registered at Police Station City Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar for offence punishable under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 filed two petitions for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

The first petition (CRM-M-15310-2020) was filed in the month of June, 2020 and listed for the first time before a Co-ordinate Bench on 01.07.2020. The Second petition (CRM-M-18002-2020) was filed in the month of July, 2020 and listed for the first time before this Court on 04.08.2020. It is surprising that the Registry did not raise an objection with regard to filing of the second petition for the same relief. Had both the petitions been not listed before the same Bench, it would result in passing contradictory orders by different Benches in the same matter and there would have been serious repercussion. The matter be brought to notice of Hon'ble the Chief Justice for doing the needful on administrative side.
