Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in FIR No.127 dated 27.06.2019 under Section 307, 353, 332, 186, 224, 436, 427, 148 and 149 IPC registered at police station Division No.7, Ludhiana.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

During the course of hearing it has gone uncontroverted that co-accused Karamjit Singh @ Kalu, Sunil Kumar, Karamjit Singh @ Joga and Ghanaiya have been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court.

On the ground of parity itself petition is allowed.

Petitioner is held entitled to bail on the reasoning adopted by the Coordinate Bench in **CRM-M-46775 of 2019 (Karamjit Singh @ Kalu Vs. State of Punjab)** decided on 08.01.2020.

Petitioner namely Ranbir Singh be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
