The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.286 dated 22.05.2020 under Sections 354, 323, 341, 506 IPC and Section 8 of the POCSO Act, Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner while praying for bail submitted that there is a dispute between the families and the complainant is his cousin and it is only on account of some fight between the two families, which seems to have allegedly taken place on account of his being in a drunken state, the twist of Section 354 IPC and Section 8 of POCSO Act has been given. It is stated that the said fact is evident from the FIR which makes no mention of the petitioner dragging her to the nearby field. The improvement was made by the prosecutrix under Section 164 Cr.P.C. knowingly well that the contents of the FIR were weak. It is further stated that the challan has already been filed.

Taking into account the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to grant him regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
