1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 24.05.2020, registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC, besides Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014 and Section 24 of Immigration Act, at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 20.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI Kuwinderjeet Singh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 20.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation on 22.07.2020 and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
5. In view of the statement of learned DAG, Punjab, order dated 20.07.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
