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RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.49 dated 30.04.2020 registered under Sections 307, 323, 326, 427, 148 & 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

It is contended by the counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. There has been no injury caused to any person in this incident. Even as per the allegations of the prosecution, the attribution against the petitioner is of causing simple

injury. There is not even MLR from Government Hospital even to support this allegation.

On the other hand, counsel for the State submits that the name of the petitioner has specifically surfaced in the incident. Further, it is not disputed that there is no MLR from the Government Hospital. It is also not disputed that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature.

In view of the above, but without commenting anything on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
