Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.101 dated 18.03.2020 registered under Sections 148/149/452/506/307 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kalanaur, District Rohtak.

The operative part of the order dated 13.07.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-
