GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Paramjit Kaur, stated to be aged 52 years, has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. *inter alia* with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.30 dated 29.02.2020, registered under Sections 454 & 380 IPC at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Vide order dated 09.07.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Risal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated

09.07.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
