The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 59 dated 06.02.2020 registered at Police Station DLF, Sector 29, Gurugram, District Gurugram, under Sections 395 & 397 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have not been framed as yet. The petitioner has been in custody for over 07 months. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner. Keeping in view the custody period as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 16.09.2020 has been presented in Court. The same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 07 months and 07 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

From the above, it is evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. Keeping in view this fact as well as the factum of custody period already undergone by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant him regular bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
